#### 3.3.1 Extension activities in the neighborhood community for holistic development of the students and to sensitize students towards social issues:

##### Response:

▶▶ डेविट कालेज से एम.टैक. की है ममता ठाकुर ने

जालंधर, 27 मार्च (नेहा) : 'कोई बच्चा पढ़ाई से वंचित न रहे, गरीब-अमीर हर बच्चे को शिक्षा ग्रहण करने का पूर्ण अधिकार है।' ये शब्द डेविट कालेज से एम.टैक. करने वाली ममता ठाकुर ने 'दैनिक सवेरा' से खास बातचीत में कहे। ममता ठाकुर ने बताया कि 'माई मिशन एजुकेशन' है जिसके तहत वह जरूरतमंद बच्चों को पढ़ाती हैं। जो बच्चे स्कूल नहीं जा सकते अथवा बहुत गरीब होने की वजह से पढ़ाई पर ध्यान नहीं दे पाते उन्हें शिक्षा प्रदान करना ममता का उद्देश्य है और इसे वह जिस हद तक हो सके पूरा करेंगी। ममता मूल रूप से कुल्लू की रहने वाली हैं। वह फिलहाल जालंधर में रह रही हैं और मध्यम वर्गीय परिवार की हैं। इनके पिता राकेश ठाकुर जंगलात महकमे कुल्लू में बतौर ब्लॉक अफसर हैं, मां सुनीता ठाकुर हाऊस वाइफ हैं और भाई अजय ठाकुर पंजाब यूनिवर्सिटी चंडीगढ़ में पढ़ रहा है।

ममता ने 'माई मिशन एजुकेशन' के बारे में कहा कि यह काम करने का विचार उन्हें कपूरथला के आर्य समाज व्यक्तित्व विकास आश्रम से आया। वह वहां एक बार गई थीं। वहां जाकर उन्होंने किसी से पूछा कि मैं आपकी मदद कैसे



ममता ठाकुर बच्चों को पढ़ाते हुए।

कर सकती हूँ तो उन्होंने जवाब में कहा कि आप बस जरूरतमंद बच्चों को पढ़ा दीजिए वही हमारे लिए सबसे बड़ी मदद होगी। ममता पहले इसी आश्रम में बच्चों को पढ़ाने जाया करती थीं। एक दिन उन्होंने डी.ए.वी. पुल के पास बस्ती में रह रहे बच्चों को देखा तो उन्हें लगा कि यहां शायद उनकी ज्यादा जरूरत है। उसके बाद ममता ने डी.ए.वी. पुल के नीचे ही बच्चों को पढ़ाना शुरू कर दिया। उसके कुछ समय बाद ममता को बच्चों को पढ़ाने के लिए कबीर नगर के मंदिर में जगह मंदिर की कमेटी की मर्जी से दी गई। इस काम की शुरुआत ममता ने सिर्फ 15 से 20 बच्चों से की थी। उसके बाद धीरे-धीरे बच्चे बढ़ते गए और आज 100 से भी ज्यादा बच्चे पढ़ने के लिए वहां आते हैं। साथ ही साथ अब उनके साथ डेविट कालेज

के 4 विद्यार्थी प्रशांत, सुमानव, निखिल और महेश इस मुहिम में जुड़े हुए हैं। ममता ने बताया कि वह इन बच्चों को सिर्फ पढ़ाती ही नहीं हैं बल्कि नैतिक मूल्यों के बारे में भी सिखाती हैं। साथ ही साथ जो बच्चे स्कूल नहीं जा पाते उनका स्कूल में दाखिला भी करवाया जाता है। उनका कहना है कि अब यह बच्चे उनका परिवार बन चुके हैं। बच्चे अपने घर की समस्याएं ममता को बताते हैं और ममता और उनकी टीम इन समस्याओं को अपनी टीम के साथ मिलकर सुलझाने की कोशिश करती हैं।

She has the target of opening more offices in rural areas of Punjab in the upcoming time

She enlightened the students that if the vision is clear, then funding is not something that can pull your initiative down. She shared that they should have complete focus and consistency towards their ideas to [build and run a successful company](#). She also shared that the budding entrepreneurs will need to create and fine-tune a business plan, assess their finances, complete all the legal paperwork, pick their partners, research apps for startup growth, and choose the best tools and systems to help them get their marketing and sales off the ground.

She also briefed during the session that there are 524 million entrepreneurs globally, and among them, 274 million women entrepreneurs are there in the world. She also highlighted the data that in India, 20.37% of women are MSME owners, accounting for 23.3% of the labour force. In addition, there are 432 million working-age women in India, and 13.5 – 15.7 million women own business that provides direct employment to 22 – 27 million people.

Dr Manoj Kumar, Principal, DAVIET, lauded the plans of Mandeep Kaur Tangra for rural Punjab. He emphasized that government policies need to focus on Rural India, creating an ecosystem for smart villages where 70% of our population lives, rather than creating Smart Cities. The efforts of Mandeep to

### **Water conservation facilities available in the Institution: Rain water harvesting**

The Institute guarantees that the water wastage remains minimal and the taps and pipes are under normal check with the up to date records being kept by the Estate Officer (EO) of the institute.

The college has Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) near the Institute Guest House adjoining Material Sciences Block. Rainwater infiltration is the major aspect of the rainwater harvesting system constructed in our institute. It is also playing an important role in storm water management and in the replenishment of the groundwater levels. Rainwater harvesting has been practiced for over 4,000 years throughout the world, traditionally in arid and semi-arid areas, and has provided drinking water, domestic water and water for livestock and small irrigation. Today, rainwater harvesting has gained much on significance as a modern, water-saving and simple technology.

01 RWH recharge pit/wells have been laid in the campus to ensure the proper percolation of rainwater to recharge and replenish the ground water. Large Open Green areas are also available at the front and backside (Sports complex) of the institute and within boundary walls of 3 hostels supporting the rapid percolation of rain water and recharge of groundwater table
