The institution joined hands with SVEEP 36 North Jalandhar to organise this camp to register a maximum number of young voters as part of the electoral rolls. Additionally, it aimed at spreading electoral awareness amongst the budding engineers to become responsible and consci-

ness. He highlighted the fact that every student above the age of eighteen should cast his vote. He also encouraged the students to be in touch with the election ambassadors of the college to clarify any doubt about the registration process and the steps involved in casting votes. He expressed his belief that all the students wouldparticipate in the election process andtake the nation forward.

ii) A SESSION ON "VOTER AWARENESS" ORGANISED ON 14/09/2022 DURING STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAM - 2022

A session was organised for the new entrants of B.Tech. on the topic "Voter Awareness". The keynote speaker was Dr. Surjit Lal Sahota, Lecturer in English & Career Counsellor. He is District Assistant Nodal Officer (SVEEP & DAPO). The session started with the definition of democracy given by Abraham Lincoln which is "of the people, for the people and by the people". . He said that every citizen of a democratic country should be aware of the value of his vote. There should be awareness regarding votes in a democratic country. In India, if anybody whose age is eighteen or above eighteen, must register himself as a voter. For online registration of a voter, he can fill the voting form from NVSP (National Voters Service Portal). There is also a mobile app for the same which is Voter Helpline App. If a person of age of eighteen or above eighteen wants to register himself as a voter, he should fill the form-6 from the app. If the person of the same age wants to register himself as a voter but he is an NRI so he should fill the form-6(a) from the app. If we want to link our aadhaar card to our voter ID card so we should fill the form-6(b) from the app. Sometimes we are present at the location which has been registered on voter ID card but we still want to vote from another place. In that case we should register ourselves as a voter from the locality where we are. But according to the laws, a citizen can register himself from one locality only. In that case, we should fill the form-7 from the app. Sometimes we forget to add some very important details to our voter ID card. In that case, we should fill the form-8 for the correction. He advised the students that as a good citizen of our nation we should make sure that if we are eighteen years old or above eighteen so we are registered as a voter.

Office Circular

This has reference to Articles 12-35 of the Indian Constitution dealing with fundamental Rights and Article 51A dealing with fundamental duties, that have been conferred upon the citizens of India. 42nd Amendment Act of 1976 added 10 Fundamental Duties to the Indian Constitution and then later, the 86th Amendment Act 2002 added the 11th Fundamental Duty to the list with the purpose that every citizen should realize that the national interest should be ahead of every action and goal and to promote harmony of the nation.

Six fundamental rights given to us are:

- Right to Equality (Article 14-18): This right guarantees equal rights for everyone, irrespective of religion, gender, caste, race or place of birth.
- 2. Right to Freedom (Article 19-22): This right guarantees freedom to citizens that includes
 - · Freedom of speech
 - · Freedom of expression
 - · Freedom of assembly without arms
 - Freedom of association
 - Freedom to practise any profession
 - Freedom to reside in any part of the country

Some of these rights are subject to certain conditions of state security, public morality and decency and friendly relations with foreign countries. State has the right to impose reasonable restrictions on them.

- Right against Exploitation (Article 23-24): This right implies the prohibition of traffic in human beings, beggar, and other forms of forced labor. It also prohibits the employment of children under 14 years in hazardous conditions.
- 4. Right to Freedom of Religion (Article 25-28): This indicates the secular nature of Indian polity. There is equ.,I respect given to all religious. Every person has the right to freely practice his or her faith, and establish and maintain religious and charitable institutions.
- Cultural and Educational Rights (Article 29-30): These rights protect the rights of religious, cultural and linguistic minorities, by facilitating them to preserve their heritage and culture.
- Right to Constitutional Remedies (Article 32): The constitution guarantees remedies if citizens' fundamental rights are violated. When these rights are violated, the citizens can approach the

List of 11 fundamental duties to be obeyed by every Indian citizen encompasses -

- 1. To abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem. This duty necessitates every citizen of India to respect and uphold the ideals and institutions of the Constitution and also respect the national symbols, such as the National Flag and National Anthem.
- To cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom. This duty necessitates every citizen of India to respect and follow the ideals of the Indian freedom struggle, such as non-violence, equality, and justice.
- 3. To uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India. That every citizen of India to defend the sovereignty, unity, and integrity of the country against all threats. It emphasizes the importance of national security and patriotism.
- 4. To defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so. This duty necessitates every citizen of India to be ready to defend the country against any external or
- 5. To promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities. It requires every citizen of India to promote communal harmony and brotherhood among all the people of the country, regardless of their religion, language, or region.
- To value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture. This duty necessitates every citizen of India to respect and preserve the rich cultural heritage of the country. It emphasizes the importance of cultural diversity and national unity.
- 7. To protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wildlife, and to have compassion for living creatures. This duty necessitates every citizen of India to protect and improve the natural environment, including forests, lakes, rivers, and wildlife emphasizing the importance of environmental conservation and sustainability.
- 8. To develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform. This duty necessitates every citizen of India to develop a scientific temper and a spirit of inquiry and reform, emphasizing the importance of scientific and rational thinking in the progress of the country.
- 9. To safeguard public property and to abjure violence. This duty necessitates every citizen of India to protect public property and renounce violence.
- 10. To strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement. It requires every citizen of India to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity.
- 11. To provide opportunities for education to their child or ward, between the age of 6 and 14 years. This duty necessitates every parent or guardian to provide opportunities for education to their child or ward, between the age of 6 and 14 years. It emphasizes the importance of education in the development of the individual and the progress of the country.
